Word	When do we use it?	Meaning	Example
this	When the object is near you (close to you)	Nearby object	<i>This</i> is my pencil.
that	When the object is far from you (not close)	Distant object	<i>That</i> is a big tree.

Simple Rules for "This" and "That"

1. Use this for things that are close.

- You can touch it or it is right next to you.
- Example: This book is on my desk.

2. Use that for things that are far away.

- You cannot touch it easily or it is across the room.
- Example: That car is on the road.
