Bossy 'e' is when the 'e' on the end of a word bosses the proceeding vowel, turning it into a long vowel sound (ie the vowel says its name instead of its sound).

The bossy 'e' is actually silent - we see it, but don't say it.
eg: rode - we say the letter 'o' in the word, but the 'e' is silent.

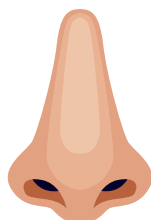

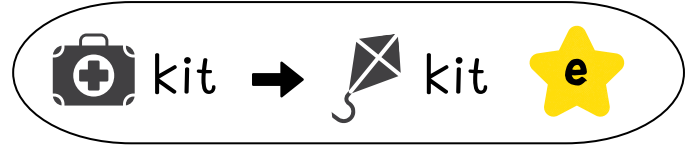
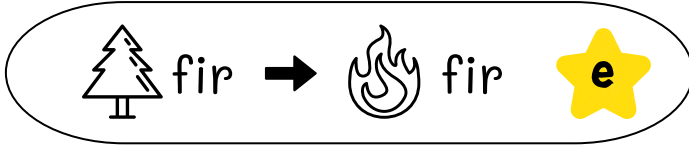
